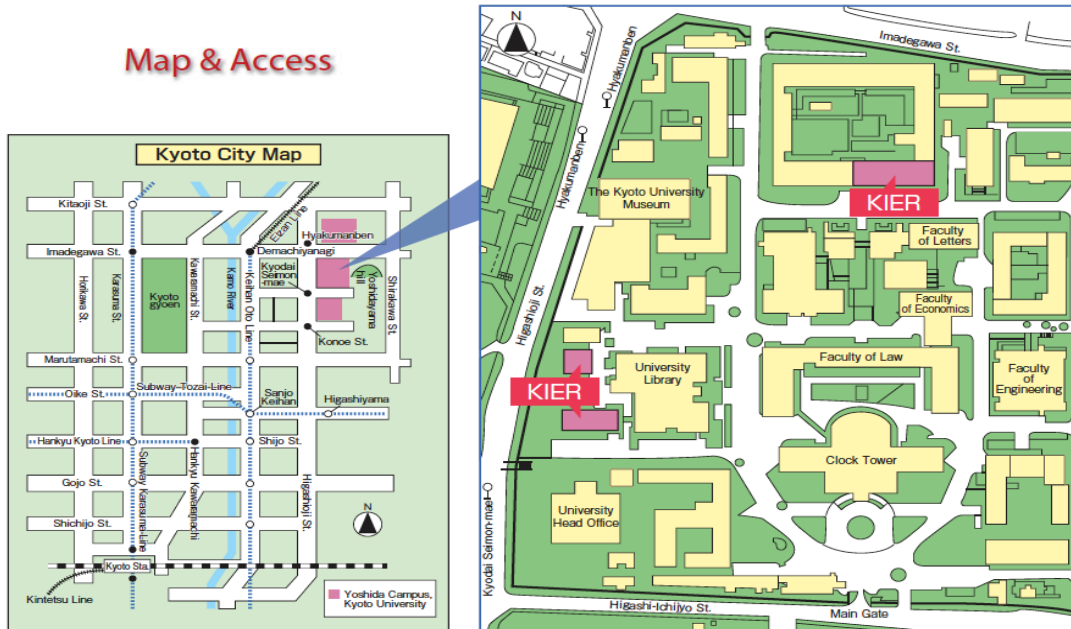

1) Train

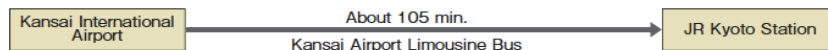
- Airport Limited Express Train "Haruka"
